Abstract:

These notes outline a social science systems theory, actor-system dynamics, drawing on the work of Walter Buckley, Margaret Archer, Thomas Baumgartner, Tom R. Burns, Philippe DeVile, Felix Geyer, and others.¹ The work has shown how key social science concepts are readily incorporated and applied in system descriptions and analyses: institutional, cultural, and normative conceptualizations; concepts of human agency and social movements; diverse types of roles and social relationships; social systems in relation to one another and in relation to the natural environment and material systems.

A key feature of the theory is its consideration of social systems as open to, and interacting with, their social and physical environments. Through interaction with their environment—as well as through internal processes—such systems acquire new properties and are
